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## SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR AUTOMOBILE MECHANICS' LOCAL NO. 701 UNION AND INDUSTRY WELFARE FUND

This is a summary of the annual report for Automobile Mechanics' Local No. 701 Union and Industry Welfare Fund, EIN 36-2331071, for the year ended December 31, 2012. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefit Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

### Insurance Information

The plan has committed itself to pay medical, prescription, dental and health benefits. The plan has contracts with Vision Service Plan, Fort Dearborn Life Insurance Company and Unum Life Insurance Company of America for vision, life, long term disability and accidental death and dismemberment claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The gross premiums paid for the contract year ending December 31, 2012 was \$466,612, \$5,375 and \$5,578 respectively.

### Basic Financial Statement

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$188,736,069 as of December 31, 2012, compared to \$172,385,843 as of January 1, 2012. During the plan year, the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$16,350,226. This increase included unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$92,088,131 including (but not limited to) employer contributions of \$67,075,195, participant contributions of \$4,543,465, realized gains of \$12,485,219 from the sales of assets and earnings on investments of \$4,771,288.

Plan expenses were \$75,737,905. These expenses included \$8,215,557 in administrative expenses and \$67,522,348 in benefits paid to participants, beneficiaries and benefit providers.

If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover the copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan at 500 West Plainfield Road, Countryside, IL 60525 and the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
